The A/V Media Manager provides support for all production and administrative tasks at the Javits Center. This role will be responsible for working with the Show Electric Department and other media managers to implement, oversee, and maintain the Internal IPTV network for the Javits Center as well as maintaining the current audio systems. This role will also be the lead on new projects pertaining to the audio integration of the Javits Center's north building.
